Don't forget that imported mixtures that are CLP hazardous are in scope for notification! Any or all substances driving the mixture classification must be notified to ECHA within one month of import on or after 1 December 2010. This will lead to many notifications being due by 1 January 2011!

There is no tonnage threshold like there is in REACH!

As of 20 January 2009 the regulation on the Classification, Labelling and Packaging of Substances and Mixtures (CLP) [Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008] entered into force. This regulation replaces earlier Directives and has officially become the de facto European Union (EU) standard for classification of substances and mixtures with regard to their physical, health, and environmental hazards; labeling criteria and language requirements; and limited packaging requirements.

ARCADIS has the expertise and resources to help companies meet key CLP compliance deadlines for their substances (1 December 2010 for compliant SDSs, labels and packaging), C&L Notifications (initial deadline of 1 January 2011) and mixtures (1 June 2015 for compliant SDSs, labels and packaging).
